SUBJECT: Absentee Ballot Address Information

Any Malheur County voter may request their ballot be sent to a temporary mailing address while they are away from their permanent residential address.

We know, for instance, that many students go off to college, military are stationed away from home, missionaries locate to a foreign country, hunters leave the area, and travelers spend the winter in another location.

To accommodate voters under these and similar circumstances, absentee ballots can be requested early. Requests can be mailed to the Malheur County Clerk, 251 B Street West #4, Vale, Or 97918 OR scan and email the request to countyclerk@malheurco.org. The voters signed absentee request should state their name, permanent residence address, mailing address, the date period that they will be absent and reason for being away (student, military, mission, hunting, etc). Only voters away from home should request an absentee ballot.

Military and overseas voters	Sept 24 th
States outside of Oregon voters	Oct 10 th
All Oregon voters (includes regular VBM ballots)	Oct 19 th

VOTED BALLOTS ARE REQUIRED TO BE RECEIVED BY ANY OREGON COUNTY CLERK/ELECTION OFFICE OR OFFICIAL DROP BOX NO LATER THAN 8:00 PM ELECTION DAY, NOV 8, 2016 IN ORDER TO BE VERIFIED, OPENED AND COUNTED. POST MARKS ARE NOT CONSIDERED RECEIVED!
